Code Change Process

Virginia's building and fire codes are state regulations, and as such, a formal process is used to update them to the latest model codes and standards. That process can be tracked on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall (<http://townhall.virginia.gov/>).

Virginia Regulatory Town Hall

- Tracks the entire code change process
- Includes dates for public hearings and public comment periods
- Provides links to the publication of the proposed and final stages of the regulation in the Virginia Register

Workgroups

- DHCD uses workgroups to facilitate client group interaction during the code development process.
- Workgroups are open to the public. If you would like to be added to the notification list for workgroups, please contact sbco@dhcd.virginia.gov.
- Workgroups determine if proposals have consensus support or should receive full review by the Board of Housing and Community Development
- Workgroup meetings and agendas can be found on the code development pages

DHCD's Code Development Webpages

- The Board of Housing and Community Development meetings and agendas are posted on the code development webpages.
- Important notices and dates from Town Hall are posted on the code development webpage for convenience, but the full process and official information is maintained on Town Hall.
- Information on the previous code development cycle is maintained on a separate webpage.

Prior to the 2015 code development cycle, DHCD partnered with the International Code Council (ICC) to develop a customized code development system, similar to ICC's cdpACCESS, for Virginia. cdpVA (Code development process Virginia) was launched and proved to be invaluable during the 2015 cycle. cdpVA was upgraded in 2018 with several improvements and new features. The upgraded system will be launched when cdpVA is opened for the 2018 code development cycle (February 18, 2019)
